The Governor spoke very positively and enthusiastically about the Men's Shed Association in Australia in general and about Victoria in particular. The Governor's speech also acknowledged the enormous impact that Men's Sheds had made to their various local communities. All of this was enthusiastically received.

Men's Shed President Lindsay Oats then took up the response and spoke thoughtfully and humorously, also making a particular point about the unattached men who make up meaningful proportion of Men's Sheds membership. He ended his 'also well received' speech with the call to "give yourselves a clap and enjoy the night".

We did! The Mansion's ground floor rooms, Drawing, Main Hallway, Billiards, and Dining were then opened for us to visit and marvel. What an experience. "Tony" Howard stopped by and passed some time with us and somewhat later, we found ourselves in front of the Governor. Luckily, I was wearing my 'Hobson's Bay Men's Shed' name tag and after she read this aloud was told that "you have the biggest shed in Victoria and quite probably Australia". I then responded that "you are clearly very well informed your Excellency" to which she replied very humorously, "Yes, I am". We then conversed about the kind of interests and projects that went on at our shed and she also queried how the members actually got to learn how to use the various tools to make things.
