Old enamel mugs, the more chipped and battered the better.

The KQ Restoration group are after the above for the "Smoko Hut" on the explosives reserve.

The Smoko Hut is an original lean to shed built behind the stables @ the Keepers Quarters on the reserve. Workers at the grounds during The Depression would gather there for morning tea and other breaks. There was an open flued fire at one end and bench table and chairs. They would boil a billy for tea and sit around telling yarns while having a quiet "puff" or two. This structure has somewhat survived and has recently been restored. The workers used to leave their enamel mugs on pegs/nails on the wall. Obviously the mugs have disappeared over the years and we are keen to restore this effect for future open days (first Sunday of the month between 1.00pm and 4.00pm, all welcome). Take a step back in time and join us.

Please hand the mugs to any COM member and they will make their way to us.
